

My Web Site Project



Project Description

You are going to create a two page Web site. **Your site will tell the visitor about yourself and some of your interests.** Your site will include the HTML concepts we learned in class.

Project Steps (Before you begin coding your page)

1. **Read ALL project instructions BEFORE you do ANYTHING else!**
2. Develop your text in a Word document
 - a. Include all text for headings, subheadings, paragraphs and lists
 - b. Check spelling and grammar
3. Collect images for both pages of your site.
 - a. Include one picture of yourself
4. Email yourself the images and text
5. Complete a storyboard for each page of your Web site.
 - a. Turn in your storyboard handout for approval.
6. Create a root folder named pX_html_lastname (X is your period)

Page 1 must include the following (you can include more):

1. Correctly named home page
2. Two complete paragraphs on your home page with pictures.
 - a. **First paragraph:** Discusses you. Included a picture of yourself>
 - b. **Second paragraph:** Include a picture.
 - i. This paragraph **might** be about your family, friends, etc.
3. A title
4. Heading and subheadings
5. Sub headings
6. Background color or image
7. Name with last update date
8. Text styled with color, font family, & size.
9. Two images with alignment, vspace and/or hspace, & alt tags.
10. Relative link to second page

Page 2 of site can be about anything that interests you.

You must include the following (you can include more):

1. Two paragraphs and at least one image
2. Title, headings and subheadings
3. Background formatting
4. Styled text
5. Relative link to home page
6. Images with alignment, vspace and/or hspace, & alt tags.

Include on either page 1 or 2

1. An absolute link
2. A list (either ordered or unordered)
 - a. **Example:** Your favorite things in a category (songs, movies, friends, etc.)

Keep in mind that background and fonts must complement each other.

Other Information:

1. Copy and paste your root folder into Web Design Dropbox on the server
2. Spelling, grammar and punctuation will be graded.
3. This project will be presented to the class in a Gallery Walk so keep it appropriate for all viewers.

- Use the style_template located in the HTML Project folder.
- I recommend you use a horizontal navigation bar.

Steps:

1. Use the style_template.html located in the HTML Project folder
2. All code after HTML on the site is copied/pasted between the body tags.
3. All code after CSS on the site is copied/pasted between the <style></style> tags in the head section of the template.
